 EVEN WITH ADVANCED AIR BAGS

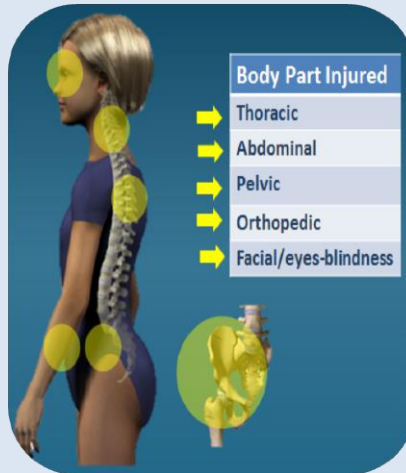
- Children can be killed or seriously injured by the air bag
- The back seat is the safest place for children
- Never put a rear-facing child seat in the front
- Always use seat belts and child restraints
- See owner's manual for more information about air bags

AIRBAGS

- ✓ Save adult lives!
- ✓ But can *kill* or *injure* a child or young teen
- ✓ *Keep kids riding in the back seat!*

WHY KIDS IN THE BACK SEAT?

- ✓ Airbags deploy at 160-300mph
- ✓ Airbags are designed for adults with seat belt
- ✓ Children & young teens can be killed or severely injured



Children and teens are lighter, smaller and have bones still developing compared to adults. As a result they are unable to take a 160-300 mph impact from an airbag

Keep children and teens riding in the back seat until they learn to drive. Unless you have no option because the back seats are occupied with younger children, other than that, do not take a risk and keep them riding in the back seat. In addition to airbags intrusion from the dashboard in older vehicles are additional risk for children and teens.
