

Your Responsibility Code*

1

Stay In Control



Stay in control, and be able to stop or avoid other people or objects

2

Those in front have right-of-way



People ahead of you have the right of way. It is your responsibility to avoid them

3

Do not stop & block



You must not stop where you obstruct a trail, or are not visible from above

4

Starting or merging look uphill



Whenever starting downhill or merging into a trail, look uphill and yield to others

5

Prevent runaway equipment



Always use devices to help prevent runaway equipment

6

Observe signs



Observe all posted signs and warnings. Keep off closed trails and out of closed areas

7



Prior to using any lift, you must have the knowledge and ability to load, ride and unload safely
